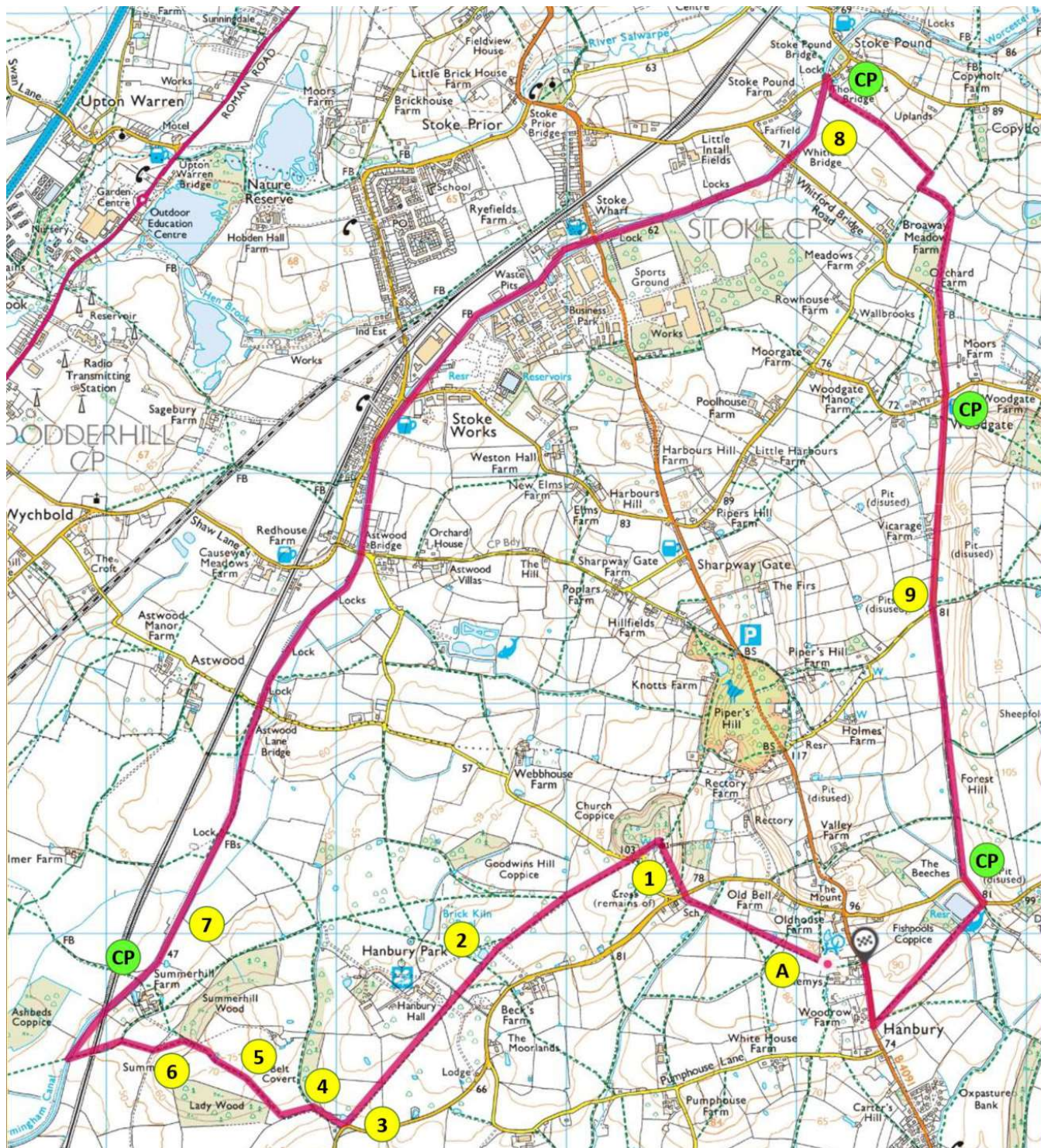


- A. Take footpath from Jinney Ring to Hanbury Church. Follow path across fields towards school in direction of Hanbury church. At the school, Carefully cross road and take stile opposite, continue steeply straight uphill to churchyard.
1. Continue through churchyard to main gates, then go down road bearing right and through kissing gate on left to enter parkland of Hanbury Hall.
 2. Cross diagonally to kissing gate and head for avenue of oak trees, through 2 kissing gates and past main gates of Hanbury hall on your right.
 3. Go through next kissing gate and head diagonally across parkland to kissing gate to roadside.
 4. Turn immediately right through adjacent gate with fence on your right. Continue through kissing gate, following field edge on your right. At corner, ignore footpath ahead and bear left with field hedge on your right. Continue till you reach footbridge.
 5. Turn right and cross footbridge. Head for corner of the wood and waymarker. Bear slightly right and head for clump of trees on top of the hill.
 6. Continue over brow of hill to kissing gate. Ignore track towards farm and bear diagonally left downhill towards field gate. Go through the gate and continue with hedge on your right, passing footpath on right, straight ahead over railway bridge to canal and turn right.
 7. Continue on towpath for 3 miles to Thomson's Bridge.
 8. Leave canal towpath just before bridge 47 Thomson's Bridge through a gap in the hedge on the right and onto a footpath. Continue through a kissing gate obliquely across the field to another gate, carry straight on to double kissing gate and ditch crossing. Turn right to a gate opening turn left across the field to a finger post. Go through the gate over a stile and across field to the next gate. Carry on straight through part of a old orchard towards a garden fence and follow this round to a kissing gate through a small field to a double set of gates and stream bridge. Carry straight on along the hedge, over two styles to join Whitford Bridge Road.
 9. At the bend take the bridleway opposite to the end at Forest Lane (caution here as the road is quite busy). Turn left along the verge until you see drive way where the road bends left uphill. Cross the road carefully and turn right onto a footpath on the left side of a fishing lake. Follow this to where it meets the Hanbury road opposite Woodrow Farm. Cross the road and follow the footpath right uphill to Jinney Ring.
